

CONQUER DOUBT – PART 3

INTIMACY WITH GOD AND UNDERSTANDING ABOUT GOD

(1) GOD'S HEART IS FOR A LOVE RELATIONSHIP WITH US

Luke 10:27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

1Cor. 1:9 God *is* faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Prov. 15:8 The sacrifice of the wicked *is* an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright is his delight.

Zeph. 3:17 The LORD thy God in the midst of thee *is* mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

Psa. 32:7 Thou *art* my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.

Psa. 31:23 O love the LORD, all ye his saints: *for* the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.

2Cor. 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, *be* with you all. Amen.

Phil. 2:1 if *there be* therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies.

Rom. 15:30 Now I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the love of the Spirit, that ye strive together with me in *your* prayers to God for me.

Heb. 2:11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified *are* all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren.

Eph. 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, Eph. 3:18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

Eph. 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

(2) GOD IS A "FAITH GOD"

Heb. 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Is. 55:9 For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Is. 55:10 For *as* the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

Is. 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent it.

Heb. 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Heb. 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if *any man* draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

Heb. 3:10 Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in *their* heart; and they have not known my ways.

Gal. 3:5 He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, *doeth he it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Rom. 3:27 Where *is* boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith.

Mark 6:5 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed *them*.

(3) GOD IS SEEKING "PRAISERS AND WORSHIPPERS"

John 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

John 4:24 God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.

Psa. 69:30 I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving.

Psa. 69:31 This also shall please the LORD better than an ox or bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

Psa. 67:5 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee.

Psa. 67:6 Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us.

Psa. 67:7 God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear him.

Acts 2:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

John 12:1 Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.

John 12:2 There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.

John 12:3 Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

Heb. 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to his name.

Psa. 34:1 I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise *shall* continually *be* in my mouth.

Eph. 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord.

1Cor. 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also; I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

ROM 4:19 -20 (Amplified) He did not weaken in faith when he considered the [utter] impotence of his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or [when he considered] the barrenness of Sarah's [deadened] womb. **20** No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God.
