DESIRE

- <u>Psa. 1:1</u> Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.
- <u>Psa. 1:2</u> But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. <u>Psa. 1:3</u> And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
- Psa. 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.
- Psa. 73:25 Whom have I in heaven but thee? and there is none upon earth that I desire beside thee.
- Psa. 145:19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.
- <u>Prov. 3:3</u> Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart: <u>Prov. 3:4</u> So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.
- <u>1 COR 14:1 (Amplified)</u> EAGERLY PURSUE and seek to acquire [this] love [make it your aim, your great quest]; and earnestly desire and cultivate the spiritual endowments (gifts), especially that you may prophesy (${}^{[}\underline{a}^{]}$ interpret the divine will and purpose in inspired preaching and teaching).
- Psa. 19:11 Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.
- $\underline{Psa.\ 31:23}$ O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.
- <u>Prov. 24:14</u> So *shall* the knowledge of wisdom be unto thy soul: when thou hast found it, then there shall be a reward, and thy expectation shall not be cut off.
- Matt. 5:46 For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?
- Matt. 6:6 But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.
- <u>James 1:25</u> But whose looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- Heb. 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
- <u>Gal. 6:7</u> Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. <u>Gal. 6:9</u> And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
- Matt. 7:11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?
- John 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

DISCIPLINE

- Rom. 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

 Rom. 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- Heb. 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Heb. 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith.
- Heb. 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
- Prov. 12:24 The hand of the diligent shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under tribute.
- <u>Gal. 5:17</u> For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.
- <u>Luke 11:21</u> When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace: <u>Luke 11:22</u> But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.
- 1Cor. 9:27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.
- 1 COR 9:27 (Amplified) But [like a boxer] I buffet my body [handle it roughly, discipline it by hardships] and subdue it, for fear that after proclaiming to others the Gospel and things pertaining to it, I myself should become unfit [not stand the test, be unapproved and rejected as a counterfeit].
- <u>1Pet. 4:1</u> Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for <u>he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin.</u>
- James 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;
- James 1:3 Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.
- <u>James 1:4</u> But let patience have *her* perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.
