

# D'S TO DESTINY

## DIRECTION

Psa. 25:10 All the paths of the LORD *are* mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.

Prov. 20:5 Counsel in the heart of man *is like* deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out.

Psa. 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

Is. 28:11 For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people.

Zeph. 3:9 For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him with one consent.

Mark 13:34 *For the Son of man is* as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

1Cor. 7:20 Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.

Is. 48:17 Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; *I am* the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way *that* thou shouldest go.

## DISCIPLINE

1Pet. 4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for *he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;*

1Pet. 4:2 That he no longer should live the rest of *his* time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

1Cor. 9:27 But *I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection:* lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

**1 COR 9:27 (Amp) But [like a boxer] I buffet my body [handle it roughly, discipline it by hardships] and subdue it, for fear that after proclaiming to others the Gospel and things pertaining to it, I myself should become unfit [not stand the test, be unapproved and rejected as a counterfeit].**

Heb. 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, *let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us,* and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Heb. 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith.

Matt. 26:41 *Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation:* the spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.

1Tim. 4:8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but *godliness is profitable unto all things,* having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

Prov. 6:20 My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother: Prov. 6:21 Bind them continually upon thine heart, *and tie them about thy neck.* Prov. 6:22 *When thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; and when thou awakest, it shall talk with thee.* Prov. 6:23 For the commandment *is* a lamp; and the law *is* light; and reproofs of instruction *are* the way of life:

Prov. 4:20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Prov. 4:21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. Prov. 4:22 For they *are* life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Prov. 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it *are* the issues of life

Mark 4:19 And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

Col. 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Col. 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. Col. 3:3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. Col. 3:4 When Christ, *who is* our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

Heb. 5:13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness; for he is a babe. Heb. 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Luke 11:21 When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace: Luke 11:22 But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.

2Pet. 2:8 (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;) )
