# ENDURANCE - PATIENCE

ENDURE (Greek - hoop-om-en'-o) to stay, remain, undergo, have fortitude, persevere, abide, cheerful or hopeful endurance, patient continuance.

PATIENCE = Same word as endurance.

#### PATIENCE IS DEVELOPED NOT INHERITED

ROM 5:3-5 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that <u>tribulation worketh</u> <u>patience</u>; <sup>4</sup>And patience, <u>experience</u>; and experience, hope: <sup>5</sup>And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

JAMES 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; <sup>3</sup>Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. <sup>4</sup>But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

## PATIENCE IS DEVELOPED THROUGH "EXPERIENCING" GOD'S MERCY

<u>EPH 3:17-20 (Amp)</u> May Christ through your faith [actually] dwell (settle down, abide, make His permanent home) in your hearts! May you be rooted deep in love and founded securely on love,

<sup>18</sup>That you may have the power and be strong to apprehend and grasp with all the saints [God's devoted people, <u>the</u>

experience of that love] what is the breadth and length and height and depth [of it];

<sup>19</sup>[That you may really come] to know [practically, through experience for yourselves] the love of Christ, which far surpasses <sup>[b]</sup>mere knowledge [without experience]; that you may be filled [through all your being] <sup>[c]</sup>unto all the fullness of God [may have the richest measure of the divine Presence, and become a body wholly filled and flooded with God Himself]!

<sup>20</sup>Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]—

PS 52:1 Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God endureth continually.

PS 40:2-3 He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings. <sup>3</sup>And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

ROM 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

ROM 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

TITUS 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost.

<u>ROM 8:5</u> For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

2 TIM 1:12 I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

#### PATIENCE AND FAITH ARE PARTNERS

HEB 10:35-36 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. <sup>36</sup>For <u>ye have need of patience</u>, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

HEB 12:1-2 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us <u>run with patience</u> the race that is set before us, <sup>2</sup>Looking

unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith.

HEB 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

<u>LUKE 8:15</u> But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and <u>bring forth fruit with patience</u>.

JAMES 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

<u>Mark 4:16</u> And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;

<u>Mark 4:17</u> And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

 $\underline{\text{LUKE 21:19}}$  (Amplified) By your steadfastness and patient endurance you shall win the true life of your souls.

## **DEVELOPING ENDURANCE**

## (1) FEED ON "FAITH FOOD"

1 PET 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby.

ACTS 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

ACTS 17:11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

PROV 4:20-23 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. <sup>21</sup>Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. <sup>22</sup>For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. <sup>23</sup>Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

PROV 3:3-4 Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart: <sup>4</sup>So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.

Prov. 6:20 My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

Prov. 6:21 Bind them continually upon thine heart, and tie them about thy neck.

<u>Prov. 6:22</u> When thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; and *when* thou awakest, it shall talk with thee.

<u>2Tim. 3:16</u> All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.

<u>Gal. 3:5</u> He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, *doeth he it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

## (2) MAINTAIN YOUR JOY, LAUGH MORE

NEH 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our LORD: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

HEB 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped (JOYFULLY EXPECTED) for, the evidence of things not seen.

GEB 21:6 And Sarah said, God hath made me to laugh, so that all that hear will laugh with me.

JAMES 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; <sup>3</sup>Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. <sup>4</sup>But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

PS 27:6 And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.

## (3) SURROUND YOURSELF WITH POSITIVE, FAITH PEOPLE

ACTS 2:46-47 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, <sup>47</sup>Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

AMOS 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

MATT 18:18 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

MATT 18:19 (Amp) "Take this most seriously: A yes on earth is yes in heaven; a no on earth is no in heaven. What you say to one another is eternal. I mean this. When two of you get together on anything at all on earth and make a prayer of it, my Father in heaven goes into action.

GEN 11:6 And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.

<u>Heb. 10:25</u> Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting *one another*: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

## (4) PRAY WITH AUTHORITY, GOD WILL CHANGE THINGS FOR YOU!

ACTS 4:29-31 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, <sup>30</sup>By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. <sup>31</sup>And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

ACTS 12:5-11 Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. <sup>6</sup>And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison. And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands. <sup>8</sup>And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me. <sup>9</sup>And he went out, and followed him; and wist not that it was true which was done by the angel; but thought he saw a vision. <sup>10</sup>When they were past the first and the second ward, they came unto the iron gate that leadeth unto the city; which opened to them of his own accord: and they went out, and passed on through one street; and forthwith the angel departed from him. <sup>11</sup>And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the LORD hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and from all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

## (5) GUARD THE "GATES" TO YOUR HEART

PROV 15:23 A man hath joy by the answer of his mouth: and a word spoken in due season, how good is it!

PROV 15:4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

<u>ISA 61:3</u> To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

# GIVE THE DEVIL "YOUR TESTIMONY" NOT HIS!

Rev. 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
