

# **HEALING AND HEALTH – GOD’S WILL FOR YOU**

## **HEALING IS INCLUDED IN THE GOSPEL**

Acts 14:8 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother’s womb, who never had walked:

Acts 14:9 The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed, Acts 14:10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.

Acts 8:5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.

Acts 8:6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

Acts 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed *with them*: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Acts 8:8 And there was great joy in that city.

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised.

Is. 53:4 Surely he hath borne (past tense) our griefs, and carried (past tense) our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

Is. 53:5 But he *was* (past tense) wounded for our transgressions, *he was* (past tense) bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* (past tense) upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Matt. 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and healed all that were sick:

Matt. 8:17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, (Isa 53:4-5) saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

1Pet. 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Matt. 9:5 For whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk? Matt. 9:6 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

3John 1:2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. 3John 1:3 For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

James 5:15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Luke 4:40 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.

Acts 5:16 There came also a multitude *out* of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Matt. 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matt. 15:30 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them *those that were* lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them.

Matt. 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

Psa. 103:2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

Psa. 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases.

Prov. 4:20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

Prov. 4:21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.

Prov. 4:22 For they *are* life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

Prov. 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it *are* the issues of life.

Prov. 3:2 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

Prov. 3:16 Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour.

Psa. 91:16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Psa. 90:10 The days of our years *are* threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they *be* fourscore years, yet *is* their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

Prov. 9:11 For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.

Prov. 10:27 The fear of the LORD prolongeth days; but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.

Gen. 6:3 And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also *is* flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

Ex. 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

**SAVED (Greek word sozo, Strong's #4982) save, deliver or protect, HEAL, preserve, do well, be made whole.**

## **HEALING COMES BY FAITH IN "THE FINISHED WORK" ALONE**

Rom. 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

Col. 2:6 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:

Col. 2:7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

Col. 2:8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

Col. 2:9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Rom. 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Gal. 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

Matt. 9:29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

Matt. 15:28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

Matt. 9:22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

Luke 7:50 And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

Luke 8:48 And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.

Luke 17:19 And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.

Luke 18:42 And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.

John 3:27 John (The Baptist) answered and said, A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven.

Mark 6:5 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed *them*.

Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

**LUKE 8:18 (Amplified)** Be careful therefore how you listen. For to him who has [spiritual knowledge] will more be given; and from him who does not have [spiritual knowledge], even what he thinks and [a]guesses and [b]supposes that he has will be taken away.

## **HEALING CAN COME THROUGH THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT**

1Cor. 12:6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

1Cor. 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

1Cor. 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

1Cor. 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

1Cor. 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues;

1Cor. 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

**1 COR 14:1 (Amplified)** **EAGERLY PURSUE** and seek to acquire [this] love [make it your aim, your great quest]; and earnestly desire and cultivate the spiritual endowments (gifts), especially that you may prophesy ([a]interpret the divine will and purpose in inspired preaching and teaching).

**1 COR 12:31 (Amplified)** But earnestly desire and zealously cultivate the greatest and best gifts and graces (the higher gifts and the choicest graces). And yet I will show you a still more excellent way [one that is better by far and the highest of them all--love].

1Cor. 14:13 Wherefore let him that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue pray that he may interpret.

## **DISCIPLES HAVE "AUTHORITY" & "RESPONSIBILITY" TO HEAL THE SICK**

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

John 6:28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

John 6:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mark 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Matt. 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Matt. 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, (that is us) baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Matt. 28:20 Teaching them to observe (OBEY) all things whatsoever I have commanded you: (the disciples) and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.
