#### <u>SALVATION: (GREEK – SOZO) – Safe, to save, deliver or protect, heal, preserve, do well,</u> <u>make whole.</u>

Psa. 91:16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation

<u>Eph. 6:2</u> Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) <u>Eph. 6:3</u> That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

<u>Prov. 3:1</u> My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments: <u>Prov. 3:2</u> For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

<u>Prov. 28:16</u> The prince that wanteth understanding *is* also a great oppressor: *but* he that hateth covetousness shall prolong *his* days.

<u>Prov. 10:27</u> The fear of the LORD prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.

<u>3John 1:2</u> Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

<u>3John 1:3</u> For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

<u>Prov. 9:11</u> For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.

<u>Prov. 4:10</u> Hear, 0 my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many.

## JESUS HEALED US ALL 2000 YEARS AGO

Luke 4:40 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and <u>he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.</u>

<u>Acts 10:38</u> How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and <u>healing all that were oppressed of the devil</u>; for God was with him.

<u>Matt. 8:16</u> When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and <u>healed all that were sick:</u>

<u>Matt. 8:17</u> That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, <u>Himself took our infirmities, and bare *our* sicknesses.</u> Matt. 19:2 And great multitudes followed him; and he healed them there.

<u>Matt. 15:30</u> And great multitudes came unto him, having with them *those that were* lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and <u>he healed</u> <u>them:</u>

Matt. 19:2 And great multitudes followed him; and he healed them there.

Matt. 21:14 And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple; and he healed them.

<u>Acts 5:16</u> There came also a multitude *out* of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and <u>they were healed</u> <u>every one.</u>

<u>Acts 8:7</u> For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

## **HEALING IS PART OF THE "SALVATION PACKAGE"**

<u>Isa. 53:4</u> Surely <u>he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows:</u> yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

<u>Is. 53:5</u> But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

#### ISA 53:4-5 (Amp) Surely He has borne our griefs (Sicknesses, Weaknesses, and distresses) and

carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken,

smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy]. 5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He

## was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being

#### for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole.

<u>1Pet. 2:24</u> Who his own self <u>bare our sins</u> in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: <u>by whose stripes ye were healed</u>.

<u>Psa. 103:2</u> Bless the LORD, O my soul, and <u>forget not all his benefits</u>: <u>Psa. 103:3</u> Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; <u>who healeth all thy diseases;</u>

<u>Matt. 9:5</u> For whether is easier, to say, *Thy* sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk? <u>Matt. 9:6</u> But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

Heb. 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as *we are, yet* without sin.

<u>Matt. 26:26</u> And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

Matt. 26:27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, Drink ye all of it

JER 33:6 Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth.

JER 30:17 For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after.

<u>JAMES 5:15-16</u> And <u>the prayer of faith shall save the sick</u>, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. <sup>16</sup>Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

PROV 3:7-8 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. <sup>8</sup>It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

### **HEALING GLORIFIES GOD**

MATT 9:8 But when the multitudes saw *it*, they marvelled, and <u>glorified God</u>, which had given such power unto men.

<u>Matt. 15:31</u> Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and <u>they glorified the</u> <u>God of Israel.</u>

<u>Mark 2:12</u> And immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were <u>all amazed</u>, and glorified God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion.

Luke 13:13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

Luke 23:47 Now when the centurion saw what was done, <u>he glorified God</u>, saying, Certainly this was a righteous man.

John 11:4 When Jesus heard *that*, he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.

Luke 17:15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God.

<u>Luke 5:26</u> And they were all amazed, and <u>they glorified God</u>, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.

<u>2Cor. 1:20</u> For all the promises of God in him *are* yea, and in him Amen, unto the <u>glory of</u> <u>God</u> by us.

<u>John 11:40</u> Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?

## CAUSES OF SICKNESS AND EARLY DEATH

## <u>(1) SATAN</u>

<u>Acts 10:38</u> How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Mark 1:13 And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.

<u>1Cor. 5:4</u> In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,

<u>1Cor. 5:5</u> To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

<u>Psa. 27:2</u> When the wicked, *even* mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

<u>1Th. 3:5</u> For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.

<u>Matt. 4:3</u> And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

<u>Gal. 4:14</u> And my temptation which was in my flesh ye despised not, nor rejected; but received me as an angel of God, *even* as Christ Jesus.

Mark 1:13 And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.

<u>Luke 13:11</u> And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up *herself*.

Luke 13:12 And when Jesus saw her, he called *her to him*, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.

Luke 13:13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

<u>Luke 13:14</u> And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.

<u>Luke 13:15</u> The Lord then answered him, and said, *Thou* hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or *his* ass from the stall, and lead *him* away to watering? <u>Luke 13:16</u> And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

## (2) SIN AND REBELLION

<u>Col. 1:13</u> Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

<u>Prov. 3:7</u> Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. <u>Prov. 3:8</u> It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

Matt. 18:33 Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?

Matt. 18:34 And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

<u>Mark 11:25</u> And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. <u>Mark 11:26</u> But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

<u>1Tim. 1:20</u> Of whom is Hymenaeus and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto Satan, that they may learn not to blaspheme.

<u>1Cor. 6:18</u> Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

<u>2Cor. 2:10</u> To whom ye forgive any thing, I *forgive* also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave *it*, for your sakes *forgave I it* in the person of Christ; <u>2Cor. 2:11</u> Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

### (3) GENERATIONAL CURSES

<u>Gal. 3:13</u> Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree:

<u>Gal. 3:14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus</u> <u>Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.</u>

Gal. 3:29 And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.

<u>1Pet. 5:8</u> Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

<u>1Pet. 5:9</u> Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

## (4) WORD CURSES

<u>Prov. 15:4 A wholesome tongue *is* a tree of life</u>: but perverseness therein *is* a breach in the spirit.

<u>Prov. 18:20</u> A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; *and* with the increase of his lips shall he be filled.

Prov. 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

<u>Prov. 12:18</u> There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but <u>the tongue of the</u> wise *is* health.

Prov. 16:24 Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

<u>Prov. 13:3</u> He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: but he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

Prov. 18:7 A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul.

<u>Is. 54:17</u> No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue *that* shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness *is* of me, saith the LORD.

2Tim. 2:17 And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus;

# **RECEIVING OUR HEALING AND DIVINE HEALTH**

## (1) PERSONAL REVELATION OF GOD'S LOVE AND FORGIVENESS

<u>Eph. 3:17</u> That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that <u>ye, being rooted and</u> <u>grounded in love, Eph. 3:18</u> May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the <u>breadth, and length, and depth, and height; Eph. 3:19</u> And <u>to know the love of Christ,</u> <u>which passeth knowledge,</u> that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. <u>Eph. 3:20</u> Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.

EPH 3:18 (Amp) [That you may really come] to know [practically, [a]through experience for

yourselves] the love of Christ, which far surpasses [b]mere knowledge [without experience]; that

you may be filled [through all your being] [c]unto all the fullness of God [may have the richest

measure of the divine Presence, and [d]become a body wholly filled and flooded with God

#### Himself]!

## (2) HEALING MANIFEST AS WE KNOW AND ARE FULLY PERSUATED OF HIS WILL !

<u>1John 5:14</u> And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: <u>1John 5:15</u> And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

<u>2Tim. 1:12</u> For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for <u>I know whom I have believed</u>, and <u>am persuaded</u> that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

John 7:17 If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself.

## (3) HEALING MANIFEST THROUGH FAITH (TRUST) IN HIS GRACE

<u>Rom. 5:1</u> Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: <u>Rom. 5:2</u> By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. <u>Rom. 5:3</u> And not only *so*, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience.

<u>Rom. 4:16</u> Therefore *it is* of faith, that *it might be* by grace; to the end <u>the promise</u> <u>might be sure to all the seed</u>; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all.

## (4) HEALING MANIFEST THROUGH "TOTAL AGREEMENT WITH JESUS"

<u>Mark 5:36</u> As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe.

Matt. 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

Mark 6:5 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed *them*.
