<u>HEAVEN</u>

THERE ARE THREE HEAVENS

<u>2Cor. 12:2</u> I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up <u>to the third</u> heaven.

<u>EPH 6:12 (Amplifies)</u> because we have not the wrestling with blood and flesh, but with the principalities, with the authorities, with the world-rulers of the darkness of this age, with the spiritual things of the evil in the <u>heavenly places</u>.

<u>Eph. 4:10</u> He that descended is the same also that ascended <u>up far above all heavens</u>, that he might fill all things.)

<u>Cor. 15:40</u> There are also <u>celestial bodies</u>, and <u>bodies terrestrial</u>: but the glory of the celestial *is* one, and the *glory* of the terrestrial *is* another.

WHO GOES TO HEAVEN

FAITH = "TRUST IN, RELY ON, ADHERE TO"

- <u>Eph. 2:8</u> For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Eph. 2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Eph. 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
- Rom. 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
- <u>John 1:12</u> But <u>as many as received him</u>, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name
- 1Tim. 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.
- <u>Heb. 1:3</u> Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when <u>he had by himself</u> purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- Matt. 10:22 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.
- Rev. 3:5 He that OVErcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.
- 1 JOHN 3:9 (Amplifies) No one born (begotten) of God [deliberately, knowingly, and habitually] practices sin, for God's nature abides in him [His principle of life, the divine sperm, remains permanently within him]; and he cannot practice sinning because he is born (begotten) of God.
- <u>John 3:3</u> Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, <u>Except a man be born</u> again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

- <u>Titus 3:5</u> Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved <u>us</u>, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- <u>2Cor. 5:17</u> Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- <u>John 3:3</u> Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, <u>Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.</u>

WHO DOES NOT GO TO HEAVEN

- 1John 3:10 In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.
- 1John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.
- 1John 3:15 Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and <u>ye know that no murderer hath</u> eternal life abiding in him.
- 1John 3:10 In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.
- <u>Matt. 10:32</u> Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. <u>Matt. 10:33</u> <u>But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.</u>
- 1John 2:22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- 1John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father.
- 1Cor. 5:5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Matt. 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Matt. 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, <u>Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?</u>
- Matt. 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
- <u>Luke 12:37</u> Blessed *are* those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.
- <u>Luke 12:38</u> And if he shall come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants.
- <u>Luke 12:39</u> And this know, that if the goodman of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through.
- Luke 12:40 Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not.
- Luke 12:41 Then Peter said unto him, Lord, speakest thou this parable unto us, or even to all?
- <u>Luke 12:42</u> And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom *his* lord shall make ruler over his household, to give *them their* portion of meat in due season?
- Luke 12:43 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- Luke 12:44 Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.
- <u>Luke 12:45</u> But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken;

Luke 12:46 The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers. Luke 12:47 And that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.

<u>Luke 12:48</u> But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few *stripes*. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

- <u>Heb. 6:4</u> For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,
- Heb. 6:5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, Heb. 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.
- <u>Heb. 6:7</u> For the earth which drinketh in the rain that cometh oft upon it, and bringeth forth herbs meet for them by whom it is dressed, receiveth blessing from God:
- <u>Heb. 6:8</u> But that which beareth thorns and briers is rejected, and is nigh unto cursing; whose end is to be burned.
- Heb. 6:9 But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.
- <u>2Pet. 2:20</u> For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.
- <u>2Pet. 2:21</u> For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. <u>2Pet. 2:22</u> But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF REWARDS AND LEVELS OF AUTHORITY

REWARD = (GREEK-MIS-THOS') PAY FOR SERVICES, WAGES.

REWARD = (WEBSTER- Something that is given in return for good or evil done or received and especially that is given or offered for some service or attainment.

<u>Matt. 11:11</u> Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding <u>he that is least in the kingdom of heaven</u> is greater than he.

Matt. 5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

- Matt. 25:14 For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.
- Matt. 25:15 And unto one he gave five talents (ability, gifts), to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.
- Matt. 25:16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.
- Matt. 25:17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.
- Matt. 25:18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

- Matt. 25:19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them. Matt. 25:20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more. Matt. 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done. thou good and faithful servant: thou hast
- Matt. 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- Matt. 25:22 He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.
- Matt. 25:23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- Matt. 25:24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:
- Matt. 25:25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.
- Matt. 25:26 His lord answered and said unto him, <u>Thou wicked and slothful servant</u>, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:
- Matt. 25:27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.
- Matt. 25:28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.
- Matt. 25:29 For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.
- <u>James 3:1</u> My brethren, be not many masters, (teachers) <u>knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation (judgement).</u>
- "Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great [is] your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you." (Matthew 5:12)
- Matt. 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. Matt. 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
- Rom. 14:10 But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.
- <u>2 Cor. 5:10</u> For we must all appear before <u>the judgment seat of Christ</u>; that <u>every one may</u> <u>receive</u> <u>the things *done* in *his* <u>body</u>, according to that he hath done, <u>whether it be good or bad.</u></u>
- <u>2 COR 5:10 (Amplified)</u> For we must all appear and be revealed as we are before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive [his pay] according to what he has done in the body, whether good or evil [considering what his purpose and motive have been, and what he has achieved, been busy with, and given himself and his attention to accomplishing].
- Rev. 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is <u>the book of life</u>: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

 Rev. 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Rev. 20:11 And I saw <u>a great white throne</u>, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

1Cor. 3:13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

1Cor. 3:14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

1Cor. 3:15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

<u>Luke 19:17</u> And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because <u>thou hast been faithful</u> in a very little, <u>have thou authority over ten cities.</u>

Rev. 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

<u>Isa. 40:10</u> Behold, the Lord GOD will come with strong *hand*, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, <u>his reward is with him</u>, and his work before him.

<u>2Tim. 4:1</u> I charge *thee* therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead <u>at his appearing and his kingdom</u>;

2Tim. 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

<u>Matt. 25:21</u> His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, <u>I will make thee ruler over many things</u>: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

Rev. 2:4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.

Rev. 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

1Cor. 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

REV 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

REV 2:26 And he that <u>overcometh</u>, and <u>keepeth my works unto the end</u>, to him will I give power over the nations.

HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF EXCEEDING JOY

"Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present [you] faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy," (Jude 1:24)

"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field." (Matthew 13:44)

TREASURE MAY BE STORED IN HEAVEN

"Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me." (Mark 10:21)

Matt. 6:19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: Matt. 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal.

Acts 10:4 And when he looked on him, he was afraid, and said, What is it, Lord? And he said unto him, Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial (Greek word – mnay-mos'-oo-non = record, reminder) before God.

Phil. 4:15 Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only.

Phil. 4:16 For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity.

Phil. 4:17 Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.

Mal. 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

<u>Gal. 6:6</u> Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things. <u>Gal. 6:7</u> Be not deceived; <u>God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.</u>

Gen. 8:22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

NAMES OF THE SAVED ARE WRITTEN IN HEAVEN

"Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven." (Luke 10:20)

Rev. 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Mal. 3:16 Then they that feared the LORD <u>spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.</u>

WE WILL BE LIKE THE ANGELS

<u>Matt. 22:29</u> Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. <u>Matt. 22:30</u> For <u>in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage</u>, but are as the angels of God in heaven.

1Cor. 6:3 Know ye not that we shall judge angels? how much more things that pertain to this life?

WE WILL HAVE A SPIRITUAL BODY LIKE JESUS

1John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

<u>Luke 24:39</u> Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: <u>handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.</u>

John 20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believe

<u>Luke 22:30</u> That <u>ye may eat and drink at my table</u> in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Rom. 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate <u>to be conformed to the image of his Son</u>, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

1Cor. 15:42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption: 1Cor. 15:43 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power: 1Cor. 15:44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

1Cor. 15:49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

Phil. 3:21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

Rev. 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

WE WILL RECOGNIZE ONE ANOTHER

Matt. 8:11 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

LUKE 16:19-31 (The Rich man and Lazarus)

1Th. 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

1Th. 4:17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

<u>Mark 9:2</u> And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them. <u>Mark 9:3</u> And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.

Mark 9:4 And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus.

Mark 9:5 And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

CAN THE SAINTS SEE US DOWN HERE FROM HEAVEN?

Heb. 12:1 Wherefore seeing <u>we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of</u>
<u>witnesses</u>, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset *us*, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,
Heb. 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith.

Rev. 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

<u>Luke 15:10</u> Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth.

WE WILL WORK AND SERVE GOD IN MANY WAYS

Rev. 7:15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

Rev. 22:3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him.

<u>Matt. 4:10</u> Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, <u>Thou shalt</u> worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

<u>Luke 19:17</u> And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because <u>thou hast been</u> <u>faithful in a very little</u>, have thou authority over ten cities.

WHAT IS HEAVEN LIKE?

Rev 22:1-6 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.

Rev. 21:10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, (1,400 Miles Square)

Rev. 21:11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

Rev. 21:12 And had a wall great and high, (300 Feet) and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: Rev. 21:13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. Rev. 21:14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

- Rev. 21:15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. d
- Rev. 21:16 And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. (1,400 square miles) The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.
- Rev. 21:17 And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.
- Rev. 21:18 And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like unto clear glass.
- Rev. 21:19 And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;
- Rev. 21:20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.
- Rev. 21:21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.
- Rev. 21:22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it. Rev. 21:23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.
- Rev. 21:24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.
- Rev. 21:25 And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.
- Rev. 21:26 And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

 Rev. 21:27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in th Lamb's book of life.

HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF WORSHIP

<u>REV 4:8-11</u> "And the four beasts had each of them six wings about [him]; and [they were] full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. And when those beasts give glory and honour and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever, The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created."

Rev. 15:4 Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.

<u>Is. 66:22</u> For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain. <u>Is. 66:23</u> And <u>it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.</u>

Rev. 4:10 The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and <u>cast their crowns before the throne</u>, saying, <u>Rev. 4:11</u> Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for <u>thou hast created all things</u>, and for thy <u>pleasure they are and were created</u>.

<u>Psa. 69:30</u> I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving. <u>Psa. 69:31</u> This also shall please the LORD better than an ox or bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

<u>Heb. 1:6</u> And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And <u>let all the angels of God worship him.</u>

<u>Rev. 7:9</u> After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

Rev. 7:10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Rev. 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

<u>Rev. 15:3</u> And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous *are* thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true *are* thy ways, thou King of saints.

<u>Rev. 22:9</u> Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

<u>Heb. 1:6</u> And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.

<u>John 4:23</u> But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Rev. 5:11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;
