**DELIGHT** Something that gives a high degree of gratification, joy, extreme satisfaction, To take great pleasure, enjoyment.

Psa. 1:1 Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. Psa. 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. Psa. 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psa. 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

Acts 13:2 As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

Phil. 2:13 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of *his* good pleasure.

Psa. 112:1 Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. Psa. 112:2 His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed. Psa. 112:3 Wealth and riches *shall be* in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.

Psa. 30:9 What profit is there in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy truth? Psa. 30:10 Hear, O LORD, and have mercy upon me: LORD, be thou my helper. Psa. 30:11 Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing; thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness;

Psa. 30:12 To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.

2Sam. 6:14 And David danced before the LORD with all his might; and David was girded with a linen ephod.

Psa. 107:22 And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.

Psa. 141:2 Let my prayer be set forth before thee *as* incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

Heb. 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to his name.

Is. 1:19 If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land.

John 12:3 Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

Psa. 31:23 O love the LORD, all ye his saints: *for* the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.

Psa. 5:11 But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice; let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

## **DISCIPLINE**

Acts 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

1Pet. 4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin.

Psa. 34:1 I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise *shall* continually *be* in my mouth.

1Cor. 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

Psa. 61:8 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows.

Psa. 68:19 Blessed *be* the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.

Prov. 8:34 Blessed *is* the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.

## **DETERMINATION**

Heb. 10:35 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.

Heb. 10:36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Eph. 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

2Cor. 1:24 Not for that we have dominion over your faith, but are helpers of your joy: for by faith ye stand.

Rom. 4:19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: Rom. 4:20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

Rom. 4:21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

Gal. 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Gal. 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

Gal. 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

2Tim. 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

2Cor. 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen *are* temporal; but the things which are not seen *are* eternal.

Rom. 3:27 Where *is* boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith.

Rom. 4:16 Therefore *it is* of faith, that *it might be* by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,
