GOD WILL CREATE THE FRUIT OF OUR LIPS

Isa 57:19 I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to *him that is far off*, and to *him that is near*, saith the LORD; and I will heal him.

Is. 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent it

Psa. 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

HEB 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

WE ARE COMMANDED TO SPEAK GOD'S WORD

Is. 59:21 As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.

JOSHUA 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

James 2:12 So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.

Psa. 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

Eph. 4:29-30 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.³⁰ And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

OUR WORDS, "SPOKEN IN FAITH," WILL CREATE OUR DESTINY

Luke 6:45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

James 3:4 Behold also the ships, which though *they be* so great, and *are* driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

Prov. 13:3 He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: but he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

Mark 11:22-26 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*. ²⁵ And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. ²⁶ But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Mark 4:26-28 And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed (positive confessions) into the ground, (Kingdom) ²⁷ And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed (the positive confession) should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. ²⁸ For the earth (the kingdom) bringeth forth fruit of herself; (automatically) first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

Prov. 18:20-21 A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. Prov. 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

HEALING AND HEALTH ARE ENHANCED THROUGH POSITIVE "FAITH" CONFESSIONS

James 3:2 For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same *is* a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.

Prov. 12:18 There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise is health.

Prov. 16:24 Pleasant words *are as* an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

Prov. 15:30 The light of the eyes rejoiceth the heart: and a good report maketh the bones fat.

Matt. 15:11 Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man.

James 3:6 And the tongue *is* a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

Prov. 15:4 A wholesome tongue *is* a tree of life: but perverseness therein *is* a breach in the spirit.

Prov. 14:3 In the mouth of the foolish *is* a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.

Prov. 3:7-8 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. ⁸ It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

PROSPERITY IS ENHANCED THROUGH OUR "FAITH" CONFESSIONS

Psa. 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, **let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.**

1Pet. 3:10 For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

Prov. 10:11 The mouth of a righteous *man* is a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.

Prov. 13:2 A man shall eat good by the fruit of *his* mouth: but the soul of the transgressors *shall* eat violence.

Prov. 12:14 A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of *his* mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.

Psa. 91:2 I will say of the LORD, *He* is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.

2 COR 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

WE OVERCOME THE DEVIL WITH GOD'S SWORD OUT OF OUR MOUTH

1Pet. 5:8-9 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: ⁹ Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*. ²⁵ And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. ²⁶ But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. ¹⁸ And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. ¹⁹ Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

MATT 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

(WE) Put on the whole armour of God, that ye (WE) may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For (WE) wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. ¹³ Wherefore take unto (you) the whole armour of God, that (WE) may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; ¹⁵ And (OUR) feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ Above all, (WE) taking the shield of faith, wherewith (WE) shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. ¹⁷ And (WE) take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: ¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
