# **PASSION**

Zeph. 3:17 The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

<u>Psa. 32:7</u> Thou <u>art</u> my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; <u>thou shalt compass me</u> <u>about with songs of deliverance. Selah.</u>

<u>2Sam. 6:13</u> And it was so, that when they that bare the ark of the LORD had gone six paces, he sacrificed oxen and fatlings.

<u>2Sam. 6:14</u> And David danced before the LORD with all *his* might; and David *was* girded with a linen ephod.

<u>2Sam. 6:15</u> So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet.

- 1Th. 3:10 Night and day praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith?
- Eph. 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.
- 1Th. 5:17 Pray without ceasing.
- <u>Jude 1:20</u> But ye, beloved, <u>building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, <u>Jude 1:21</u> Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.</u>
- 1Tim. 2:8 I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.
- <u>Col. 4:12</u> Epaphras, who is *one* of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, <u>always labouring</u> <u>fervently for you in prayers</u>, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.
- 1Cor. 14:18 I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all.
- Matt. 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.
- <u>Dan. 10:12</u> Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for <u>from the first day that thou didst set thine</u> <u>heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words.</u>
- <u>Dan. 10:13</u> But the prince of the kingdom of <u>Persia</u> withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of <u>Persia</u>.
- Eph. 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Ex. 32:9 And the LORD said unto Moses, I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a stiffnecked people:
- Ex. 32:10 Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation.
- Ex. 32:11 And Moses besought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why doth thy wrath wax hot against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?
- Ex. 32:12 Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people.
- Ex. 32:13 Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, thy servants, to whom thou swarest by thine own self, and saidst unto them, I will multiply your seed as the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have spoken of will I give unto your seed, and they shall inherit it for ever.
- Ex. 32:14 And the LORD repented of the evil which he thought to do unto his people.
- Acts 12:5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.
- Acts 12:5 (Amplified) So Peter was kept in prison, but fervent prayer for him was persistently made to God by the church (assembly).
