THE ANOINTING - PART TWO

/ Pet 5:7-8

(1) GOD'S ANOINTING COMES THROUGH FAITHFULNESS & DILIGENCE

<u>John 8:31</u> Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, <u>If ye continue in my word</u>, <u>then are ye my disciples indeed;</u>

John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

<u>Luke 16:12</u> And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?

<u>Psa. 31:23</u> O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the <u>LORD</u> preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.

<u>Luke 16:11</u> If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true *riches*?

Matt. 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, | will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

James 4:7

1Tim. 1:12 And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry.

<u>Luke 19:17</u> And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: <u>because thou hast been faithful</u> in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities.

Acts 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

1Cor. 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord

Col. 1:23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister.

<u>Luke 18:1</u> And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint:

1Th. 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

Eph. 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.

(2) BELIEVE IN GOD'S PRINCIPAL OF SOWING & REAPING

Gen. 8:22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

Gal. 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

<u>Gal. 6:8</u> For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

Gal. 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

Rom. 2:11 For there is no respect of persons with God

Rom. 4:16 Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

<u>Is. 66:9</u> Shall I bring to the birth, and not cause to bring forth? saith the LORD: <u>shall I cause to bring forth</u>, and shut *the womb*? saith thy God.

(3) ANOINTING THROUGH ASSOCIATION, IMPARTATION AND TRANSFERENCE

Heb. 6:10 For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Heb. 6:11 And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

Heb. 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

Phil. 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

Heb. 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

<u>2Pet. 2:7</u> And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: <u>2Pet. 2:8</u> (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)

Mark 4:24 And he said unto them, <u>Take heed what ye hear</u>: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and <u>Unto you that hear shall more be given</u>.

Mark 4:25 For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath.

<u>Prov. 19:27</u> Cease, my son, to hear the instruction *that causeth* to err from the words of knowledge.

1Tim. 1:5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned.
