THE ANOINTING FOR A "POWER LIFE"

ANOINT (Heb. Mosh-khaw') Uncion, consecratory gift, to rub, touch.

<u>ANOINT (Greek – khris'mah) an unction or smearing, endowment of the Holy Spirit, the idea</u> of contact.

ANOINTING "God on flesh, doing those things flesh cannot do"

Jesus, as the son of man, needed the anointing from the father (Acts 10:38, Luke 4:18) Every Believer needs the anointing from God!

THE PURPOSE OF THE ANOINTING

TO GLORIFY AND REVEAL GOD

MATT 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

<u>2 COR 4:7</u> But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, <u>that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.</u>

2Cor. 5:20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

1Pet. 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Cor. 3:2 Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:

TO ACCOMPLISH YOUR ASSIGNMENT

<u>JOHN 15:16</u> Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that <u>ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain</u>: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

MARK 13:34 For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

<u>Eph. 2:10</u> For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, <u>which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.</u>

John 15:1 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

<u>John 15:2</u> Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every *branch* that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

John 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

TO BE TAUGHT AND LED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 JOHN 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

1 JOHN 2:20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.

Heb. 5:13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. Heb. 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

TO LIVE IN THE SUPERNATURAL RHELM

EPH 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.

<u>John 14:12</u> Verily, Verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and <u>greater works than these shall he do;</u> because I go unto my Father.

<u>Mark 16:17</u> And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; <u>Mark 16:18</u> They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

<u>Luke 10:17</u> And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. <u>Luke 10:18</u> And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. <u>Luke 10:19</u> Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

<u>John 6:28</u> Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? <u>John 6:29</u> Jesus answered and said unto them, <u>This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.</u>

<u>2Cor. 5:17</u> Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

GROW IN GOD'S ANOINTING

FIND YOUR CALLING

Rom. 11:29 For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.

Cor. 7:20 Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.

Matt. 25:15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

2Tim. 1:9 Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began.

1Cor. 12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

1Cor. 12:5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

1Cor. 12:6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

1Cor. 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

1Cor. 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; 1Cor. 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 1Cor. 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: 1Cor. 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

Rom. 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Rom. 12:7 Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, teaching; Rom. 12:8 Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

KEEP ON "KEEPING ON" (REMAIN FAITHFUL)

PROV 28:20 A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.

MATT 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy.

1 COR 14:1 (Amp) EAGERLY PURSUE and seek to acquire [this] love [make it your aim, your great quest]; and earnestly desire and cultivate the spiritual endowments (gifts), especially that you may prophesy.

1 TIM 1:12 And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry.
