

THE ANOINTING FOR A "POWER LIFE"

ANOINT (Heb. Mosh-khaw') Uncion, consecratory gift, to rub, touch.

ANOINT (Greek – khris'mah) an unction or smearing, endowment of the Holy Spirit, the idea of contact.

ANOINTING " God on flesh, doing those things flesh cannot do"

Jesus, as the son of man, needed the anointing from the father (Acts 10:38, Luke 4:18)

Every Believer needs the anointing from God!

THE PURPOSE OF THE ANOINTING

TO GLORIFY AND REVEAL GOD

MATT 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

2 COR 4:7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

2Cor. 5:20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

1Pet. 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Cor. 3:2 Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:

TO ACCOMPLISH YOUR ASSIGNMENT

JOHN 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

MARK 13:34 For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

Eph. 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

John 15:1 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

John 15:2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

John 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

TO BE TAUGHT AND LED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 JOHN 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

1 JOHN 2:20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.

Heb. 5:13 For every one that useth milk *is* unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.
Heb. 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

TO LIVE IN THE SUPERNATURAL RHELM

EPH 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; **Mark 16:18** They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. **Luke 10:18** And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. **Luke 10:19** Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 10:20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

John 6:28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

John 6:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.

2Cor. 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

GROW IN GOD'S ANOINTING

FIND YOUR CALLING

Rom. 11:29 For the gifts and calling of God *are* without repentance.

Cor. 7:20 Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.

Matt. 25:15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

2Tim. 1:9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began.

1Cor. 12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

1Cor. 12:5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

1Cor. 12:6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

1Cor. 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

1Cor. 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; **1Cor. 12:9** To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; **1Cor. 12:10** To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues;

1Cor. 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

Rom. 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, *let us prophesy* according to the proportion of faith; **Rom. 12:7** Or ministry, *let us wait on our* ministering: or he that teacheth, teaching; **Rom. 12:8** Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, *let him do it* with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

KEEP ON "KEEPING ON" (REMAIN FAITHFUL)

PROV 28:20 A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.

MATT 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy.

1 COR 14:1 (Amp) EAGERLY PURSUE and seek to acquire [this] love [make it your aim, your great quest]; and earnestly desire and cultivate the spiritual endowments (gifts), especially that you may prophesy.

1 TIM 1:12 And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry.

LUKE 16:12 And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?

1Tim. 1:12 And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;

Heb. 6:10 For God *is* not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Heb. 6:11 And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

THROUGH ASSOCIATION, IMPARTATION AND TRANSFERENCE

PROV 19:27 Cease, my son, to hear the instruction that causeth to err from the words of knowledge.

HEB 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

MARK 4:24 And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.
