

YOUR MIND CONTROLS YOUR DESTINY

Rom. 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service.

Rom. 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the **renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

James 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and **receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.**

Prov. 23:7 For **as he thinketh in his heart, so is he**: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart *is* not with thee

Heb. 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

Heb. 6:19 Which *hope* we have as an **anchor of the soul**, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

Heb. 6:20 Whither the forerunner is for us entered, *even* Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Phil. 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things *are* **honest**, whatsoever things *are* **just**, whatsoever things *are* **pure**, whatsoever things *are* **lovely**, whatsoever things *are* of good report; if *there be* any **virtue**, and if *there be* any **praise**, **think on these things.**

Prov. 16:3 Commit thy works unto the LORD, and **thy thoughts shall be established.**

Prov. 21:5 **The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness**; but of every one *that is* hasty only to want.

Psa. 40:5 Many, O LORD my God, *are* thy wonderful works *which* thou hast done, and thy thoughts *which are* to us-ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: *if* I would declare and speak *of them*, they are more than can be numbered.

Heb. 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a **discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.**

2Cor. 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, **are changed into the same image** from glory to glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord.

RENEWING (RENOVATING) OUR MIND – “MENTAL STRONGHOLDS”

(1) “LOSER” MIND SET

Judg. 6:12 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him, and said unto him, The LORD *is* with thee, thou mighty man of valour

Num. 13:33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, *which come* of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

Eph. 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Rev. 5:10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

Rom. 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

(2) "VICTIM" MIND SET

Mark 4:16 And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;

Mark 4:17 And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

Luke 17:1 Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come; but woe *unto him*, through whom they come!

Matt. 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you.

Jude 1:20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Jude 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Heb. 12:15 Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble *you*, and thereby many be defiled.

(3) "RUNT OF THE LITTER" MIND SET

James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

John 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, *then* are ye my disciples indeed; John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

John 7:17 If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or *whether* I speak of myself.

John 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

Prov. 8:17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.

Psa. 31:23 O love the LORD, all ye his saints: *for* the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.

Psa. 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

Rom. 2:11 For there is no respect of persons with God.

(4) "CIRCUMSTANCIAL PRISON" MIND SET

Num. 11:23 And the LORD said unto Moses, Is the LORD'S hand waxed short? thou shalt see now whether my word shall come to pass unto thee or not.

1Cor. 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also **make a way to escape**, that ye may be able to bear *it*.

1 COR 10:13 (NIV) No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But **when you are tempted**, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

Psa. 34:19 Many *are* the afflictions of the righteous: but **the LORD delivereth him out of them all**.

Prov. 24:16 **For a just *man* falleth seven times, and riseth up again**: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

Jude 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

Rom. 10:11 For the scripture saith, **Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed**.

"EARTH BOUND" MIND SET

Col. 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Col. 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

Col. 3:3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

Col. 3:4 When Christ, *who is* our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

1John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Mark 4:18 And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word,

Mark 4:19 And **the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things** entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

Matt. 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Matt. 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

Jer. 29:13 And ye shall seek me, and find *me*, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.
